THE MINI CHALLENGE – LISTENING TO **COMPETITORS**

THE MINI CHALLENGE IS THE CHAMPIONSHIP FOR THE NEW MINI IN THE UK, ENJOYING GREAT GRIDS, COLOURFUL CARS AND CLOSE RACING SHOWN LIVE ON ITV4.

Over the years, the MINI CHALLENGE has built a reputation for affordability, fairness and fun, and benefits from being the only Championship to enjoy the support of MINI UK, and from being televised live on ITV4 as a BTCC Support Series.

Last season the MINI CHALLENGE continued its history of listening to competitors, with a number of subtle, but important regulation changes to maximise equality, and to ensure the best drivers have the opportunity to win.

The JCW Class changes were focused on maintaining the 2-litre powerplant's excellent reliability, whilst making it easier for competitors to ensure tip top performance. Additional technical support and at event testing helped to enhance the package still further, enabling competitors to diagnose and fix any deficiencies on location, rather than having to wait until the gap between events.

This year the JCW class will continue as the natural stepping-stone for drivers with their sights set on the BTCC, with all seven race meetings on the TOCA package.

The multi-class structure enables drivers with varying degrees of experience and budget to be part of the MINI CHALLENGE, whilst providing a natural route for progression.





The Cooper Class provides close, fair racing at an entry level, and will make three appearances on the TOCA Package, Donington Park, Silverstone and Thruxton. A further two events will be as a British Truck Racing support championship at Pembrey and Brands Hatch, with seven race meetings in total. All rounds will either be shown live on ITV4, or streamed via social media platforms.

2024 will ensure the R50-based cars continue to be one of the fairest and most cost-effective ways to go racing, whilst also offering competitors the highest profile exposure.

Budgets are also kept under control through restrictions on testing and tyre use, as well as widespread use of control parts in areas where any performance advantage could be gained.

The MINI CHALLENGE is 'The Place to Race'.

The **JCW Class** sits at the top of the **MINI CHALLENGE**, offering a specification that is closer to the BTCC cars it shares a stage with than any other single-make championship in the UK - but at a fraction of the cost.

Goodyear slick tyres, a Damico tuned 2-litre engine, Quaife sequential gearbox, three-way adjustable Nitron dampers and Alcon brakes ensure the **JCW Class** provides the perfect stepping stone to touring car racing while representing the **'Best of British'**.





COOPER CLASS

It might be the first rung on the ladder, but the Cooper Class often produces the most exciting racing the MINI CHALLENGE can offer.

The **Cooper Class** made three highly successful guest appearances events on the BTCC calendar for the last three seasons, and will return to entertain fans at another three events on the highest stage in UK motorsport during the 2024 season.

The entry level **Cooper Class** car uses a 130bhp 1.6-litre normally aspirated engine, six-speed manual gearbox and Goodyear slick and wet tyres, limited to four new tyres per race meeting with up to 8 new tyres in the first meeting.

In the interest of simplicity and keeping control of budgets, the adjustability of the cars is kept to a minimum. Modifications to toe, ride height and the single-way AST control dampers are all that is available, making the Cooper Class the ideal place for drivers to gain experience. The car is best suited to drivers new to car racing, those with some karting experience, or those who simply want to enjoy the close, fair racing of the **MINI CHALLENGE** on a high profile stage, but with a tightly controlled budget.

THE AWARDS

The race winner, runner up and third place in both classes will be awarded trophies in all races.


The overall **MINI CHALLENGE** Champion, Runner Up and 3rd placed driver in both classes will receive end of season trophies. As well as the overall class championships, points are also awarded towards a number of other titles throughout the season.

The **Rookie Cup** is awarded to the top newcomer in each class, allowing those new to the Championship the chance to fight for a title of their own whilst getting to grips with new machinery. Similarly, the **Graduate Cup** will be awarded to the highest placed 2nd year **MINI CHALLENGE** driver in each class.

For those competitors over the age of 35, points are awarded towards the **Directors Cup**, meaning drivers of all ages and experience levels have the chance to claim a crown.
